Best Man Duties

BEFORE THE WEDDING DAY —
\square Be supportive and available for the groom when he needs you –
it will be a super emotional day for him, too!
□ Help him to choose a suit for the wedding
□ Remember to attend the suit fittings already organized for you
and the groomsmen – organize the groomsmen: you need to
match shoes, ties, etc.
\square Plan a bachelors party – ask the others to help you with this
\square Help the maid of honor in organizing accommodation and
transport for everyone
BACHELOR'S PARTY —
□ Choose a date, time and venue
□ Set up a budget
□ Create a guest list and get their contact details
□ Send out invitations
□ Manage RSVP's or ask a groomsman to handle this
□ Organize food and drinks if the venue doesn't provide it
□ Organize good music (create a playlist)
□ Be sure to appoint designated drivers for the party
□ Organize additional entertainment for the evening if necessary
□ Put someone in charge of cleaning up after the party if
necessary

ON THE WEDDING DAY

CEREMONY

\square Get to know the wedding schedule and details
\square Check that the groom eats a hearty breakfast and stay
hydrated – no alcohol!
\square Check that the groom and groomsmen stay on schedule
\square Get dressed – help the groom to fasten his tie and straighten
out his suit
\square Have a groom's emergency kit on hand, just in case: band-aids,
concealer (yes!), safety pins, needle and thread, etc.
\square Hold the bride's ring until the exchanging of the vows and rings
at the ceremony – double check that your pockets don't have
holes!
□ Make sure that everyone's boutonnieres are fastened on
properly and facing the correct way
\square If required, sign the wedding register as a witness along with the
maid of honor
\square When walking out, do so with the maid of honor on your side
\square Check that the groom and groomsmen's suits are neat and tidy
during the photo session
\square Help the maid of honor to assist the bride and groom when
photos are taken in difficult angles or spaces

RECEPTION ☐ At the reception, get ready to enter and be announced with the maid of honor ☐ Traditionally, you also have to dance with the maid of honor during the first formal dance ☐ Ask the groom if you can dish up for him at the buffet, along with the maid of honor who dishes up for the bride - although, a lot of couples prefer to do this themselves ☐ Give a toast or speech after the father of the groom, before the maid of honor gives her speech ☐ Be a host at the wedding - help the guests to find the gift table and encourage them to sign the guest book \square If the dance floor is empty, encourage the groomsmen and bridesmaids to help you keep it going (bored guests will leave early) ☐ Help the maid of honor to handle the gifts - put them in the car or hotel room of the person responsible for safe keeping (usually a bridesmaid or family member) ☐ When it is time to throw the garter, help the bride get onto the chair - encourage all the single men to join in in catching the garter ☐ Liaise with the Master of Cermonies for further arrangements
